1. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION

Welcome

We are glad to welcome you to our Rally Chile BIOBÍO 2023. The biggest motorsport event in Chile will take place from September 28th to 01st of October.

In 2019, we made history to bring the World Rally Championship for the first time to Concepción. This year we have the honour to welcome again WRC, its competitors, and the true fans.

COPEC RallyMobil National Championship has created a reputation throughout the whole World because of its amazing gravel stages and great atmosphere.

Thanks to the support of the Regional Government of BIOBÍO, local authorities, the 3 provinces and their 33 municipalities, our sponsors, official teams and brands associated, we are very proud to deliver this event and allow all rally fans a unique opportunity to enjoy a fantastic rally weekend with the huge support of the Chilean police department that is the key to make sure that each stage will be very safe for all those participating and spectating.

Locations

Rally HQ, Media Centre and Service Park will be in the MDS Hotel (Ex Sonesta Hotel) Talcahuano, Concepción. The Service Park will be located on the same spot as in 2019, the parking area of MDS Hotel and Casino and its surroundings. It will be the only Service Park used during the rally.

Route

The route consists mostly of twisty gravel stages, challenging to both cars and crews. The total distance of the rally is about 1.239,43 km. Sixteen special stages in total will cover about 320,98 km, which bring the rally to more than 25,90% special stage coverage.

The rally starts with Shakedown on Thursday morning, while as special stages are run from Friday morning to Sunday within 120 kilometre radius of Concepción. The special stage El Poñen is for the first time welcoming the Wolf Power Stage.

There will be 6 special stages, Friday and Saturday will each be made up of three unique special stages that will be repeated later on each day. Sunday will finish the rally with another 4 stages – 2 stages that will be driven twice. The Podium Ceremony will be held at the Stop of the Wolf Power Stage

1.1. Environmental Sustainability

As part of the FIA Environmental Sustainability Program, Rally Chile BIOBÍO goal is to continue to make the event more sustainable. While working both internally and externally, we aim to ensure that our events impact on the environment, is as small as possible. This is an ongoing process and includes provisions on special stages, in the Service Park and through our general administration tasks.

Specific goals of the organisation are as follows:

- Commit to continuously improve our environmental work in tune with the concerns of society and our interest groups.
- Competitor package will be distributed in bags made from organic cotton.
- Separate waste collection in the Service Park, HQ and Media Center.
- All materials used on the stages are removed after the rally, stored, and reused the year after.
- Constituting a high-level environmental governance within the organization of the event.
- Educate and inform as many people as possible with the organisation and externally of our environmental policy.
- Comply with relevant environmental laws and regulations of Chile, and other environmental requirements as well as the FIA Institute Environmental Certification Framework.
- Observing environmental work and environmental impact when we choose partners and suppliers ٠ and strive to choose products and services with proven good environmental performance.
- Minimize waste and recycling as much as possible through local community projects.
- Reduce the number of printed materials documents using the largest number of digital sources.

Special Initiatives

Nature Conservation

The BIOBÍO Region is a scenario of nature, biodiversity and characteristic landscapes of a forest country like Chile. Thus, we have adopted a special procedure to evaluate, anticipate and mitigate any impact that may exist on the racing areas. This procedure includes:

- Satelital data determination on each Stages based on a "multilayer criteria" Multilayer Assessment of Career Determination (M.A.C.D.) - where the initial proposal from the Clerk of the course is subjected to an exhaustive evaluation for the Conservation of Nature, considering national laws, international agreements such as WETLAND RAMSAR SITES by UNESCO and interested parties (NGO's) among others.
- Monitoring of wildlife through specialized camera traps to avoid disturbance of animal species.
- Green Marshalls equipped with deterrent noise devices to keep any animal away from the stages.
- Environmental vehicles equipped with veterinary doctors, veterinary medical supplies, rescue items and environmental information.
- Register and provide detailed information for all aircraft (Helicopters mainly) of all natural ecosystems identified in the Assessment and its strict prohibition of its overflight less than 500 feet of altitude so as not to significantly disturb different competing Ecological Points of Interest (E.P.I.) or Areas of High Conservation Value Areas (HCVA) .

"One ton CO2, One Tree" – WRC Carbon Footprint neutralization Project:

The WRC Rally Chile BIOBÍO has a strong commitment to the fight against global warming and for this, we will donate 1 tree for each ton of CO2-eq of the Carbon Footprint of the event through our green sponsor "Arauco".

Additionally, the Carbon Neutrality Program implies an environmental performance that includes a complete identification and neutralization of Greenhouse Gases through:

- Measurement of the Carbon Footprint in Scopes 1, 2 and 3 using high performance protocols such as the GHG Protocol of the World Resource Institute - WRI
- Verification reviewed by an independent third party (Deloitte)
- Neutralization of the entire Carbon Footprint through Certified Emission Reduction (Carbon Credits) registered in the Clean Development Mechanism - CDM of the United Nations Framework on Climate Change and WRC Rally Chile BIOBÍO believes that the planet is our home for future generations. It is our responsibility to be successful in caring for the environment.

5. SERVICE PARK

5.1. General Information

Location

GPS coordinates: 36°46'32.3"S 73°04'24.1"W Service park is located in the MDS Hotel and Casino, the surface is tarmac.

5.2. Access to Service Park

- On Thursday 21 September from 09.00 for Manufacturer Teams
- On Sunday 24 August from 09.00 for P2, P3 and Non-priority drivers

Exemptions could be agreed with Service Park Manager. Please contact the Service Park Manager for direction to your allocated service area.

Access

Only vehicles with Team plates issued by the Organiser are allowed to access the Service Park. The vehicles must be clearly identified by designated car pass affixed on the windscreen. Removal of the sticker is prohibited until the end of the rally.









Closing

All service buildings, tents, cars, trailers etc must be removed from the Service Park area:

- (Manufacturers teams) by Tuesday, 03 October at 07.00
- Rest of the Service Park (all other teams) by Monday, 02 October at 12.00

5.3. Service Area

• Manufacturers and WRC Teams entered to the FIA WRC will have their designated areas in the Service Park according to the Championship Regulations.

Cost for additional service space in Service Park area is $30 \in + VAT 19\% /m^2 = 35.7 \notin /m^2$. All additional space requests are subject to availability and organiser agreement. The organiser cannot guarantee any service space exceeding those given above and in the FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Appendix VI.

If a competitor has multiple entries to be located together in Service Park, the application for consecutive Service Areas must reach the Organiser by Monday, 28 August.

The layout of Service Park displaying service space designated to each competitor will be published in the Competitors section on <u>www.rallychilebiobio.com</u> and on Sportity application.

5.3.1 Traffic Movements

The traffic flow direction shown on the Service Park layout must be always respected by competitors and their service / auxiliary vehicles.

5.3.2 Parking

During the rally, only vehicles with Service and Auxiliary passes will be permitted to access the service park. Auxiliary vehicles may only enter the service park to bring or collect personnel and/ or equipment and only while no competition cars in the service park. Due to the restricted space in the Service Park, private entries will not be given any auxiliary plates. All trailers and tractor units must be removed to the dedicated truck parking area outside the Service Park.

There will be dedicated car parks for Auxiliary, Media, and Officials.

5.3.3 Power Generators

Generators are permitted in the Service Park however these must be super silent diesel or LPG. Generators must be fenced off to restrict access to competent personnel only.

5.3.4 Restrictions

It is forbidden under any circumstances to drill holes in the surface of the Service Park. Teams and competitors are asked to bring weights for tents and other items that need to be fastened.

5.4. Facilities at Service Park

Following facilities will be provided at various points around the service park as per FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Appendix VI.

- Public toilets
- Waste containers and selective collection
- General lighting
- General security
- Car wash (Located outside the Service Park).

- Additional service space (if available)
- Power supply
- Portable toilets at team service area (Priority competitors as per WRC Regulations)
- Waste removal
- Private water supply if available

- Forklift and scissors lift rental
- Crowd barriers / fencing

5.5. Environmental Requirements

Washing

A car wash facility will be available near the Service Park. Washing cars inside the Service Park is prohibited at any time. Wheels and other parts may be washed in the designated wash bays set up within the Service Park.

Groundsheet

All competitors must put in place a suitable size plastic groundsheet to cover the whole area where service work is being carried out. This groundsheet must be impervious to all fluids. Cleaning of the groundsheets must be done so that no materials are allowed to encounter the ground surface.

Recycling and Waste

For environmental reasons, all competitors are kindly asked to use the recycling areas arranged at the Service Park for waste. It is forbidden to spill any oil or wastewater on the ground in the Service Park. A special container for hazardous waste will be available in the Service Park.

Before leaving the Service Park after the rally (or possible retirement) each team must report to the Service Park Co-ordinator, who will check that their allocated area has been left in good condition.

5.6. Security

Starting from Saturday 23 September until Monday 02 October, Service Park will be open 24h with overnight security provided by the Organiser from 22.00 until 07.00.

However, the Organisers are not responsible for any losses, thefts, or damages etc – all items are left at their owner's risk.

If you require any additional private security on site, please contact the Service Park Manager.

5.7. Medical Care

A medical unit will be established in the Service Park.

5.8. Recovery of the Retired Cars

In agreement with the team representative all retired cars will be transported by the Organiser from the special stage to nearest access point. The Organiser will then contact the team representative for further agreements.

5.9. Restart Parc Fermé

Any crew re-starting the rally must present their cars at the overnight Parc Fermé according to Article 12.14 of the Supplementary Regulations. There will be a restart Parc Fermé established in adjunct to the Service Park.









6. TWO-WAY RADIO COMMUNICATION

The Chilean Ministry of Telecommunications controls the use of frequencies in Chile and ensures that enough frequencies are equally available to ensure that all users can operate in a cooperative and legal manner.

7. HELICOPTERS

7.1. General

Only helicopters from the organisation are allowed to overfly the event area to guarantee the safety of the competitors and spectators and live TV coverage.

Commercial helicopter flights are not authorised within the event area during Rally Chile BIOBÍO 2023 and landing in the neighbourhood of the special stages except when a waiver is given by the organisers.

Following FIA and WRC Promoter guidelines on helicopter use, all helicopters flying in support of the Rally must be registered with the organiser.

No drones are permitted to fly within the event area during Rally Chile BIOBÍO 2023, except those authorised for live TV coverage.
