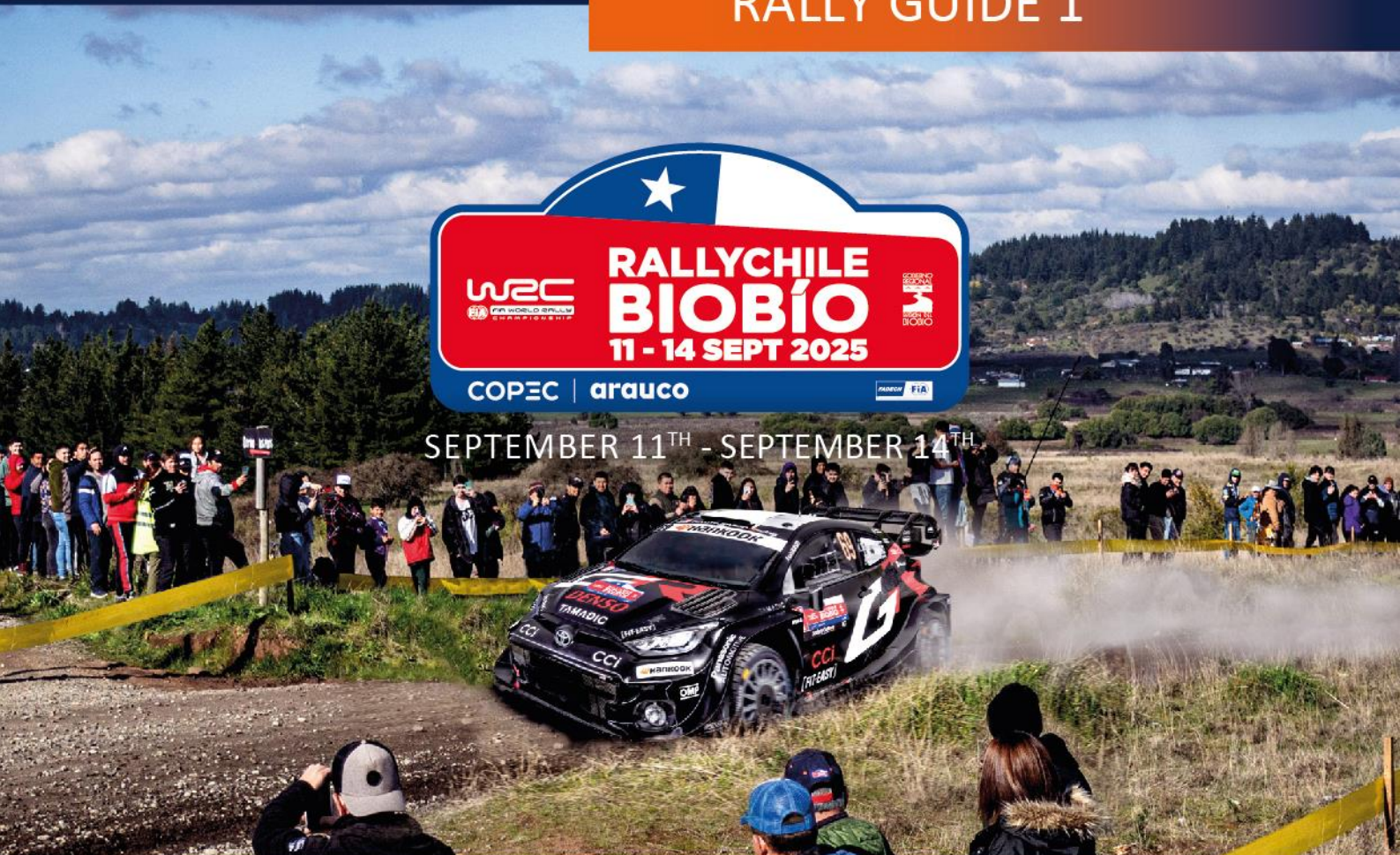

1. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION

Welcome

We are glad to welcome you to our event Rally Chile BIOBIO 2025. The biggest motorsport event in Chile will take place from September 11th to 14th of September.

In 2023-2024, we have been hosting the World Rally Championship in the south of our country, specifically in Biobio region, an ideal location that has accompanied us over the years thanks to its natural beauty and perfectly maintained roads. This year for the fourth time, we have the honour to welcome again the WRC event, its competitors, and the true rally fans. COPEC RallyMobil National Championship has created a reputation throughout the whole world because of its amazing gravel stages and great atmosphere.

Thanks to the support of the Regional Government of BIOBIO, local authorities, the 3 provinces and their 33 municipalities, our sponsors, official teams and brands associated, we are very proud to deliver this event and allow all rally fans a unique opportunity to enjoy a fantastic competitive weekend with the huge support of the Chilean police department who are the key to make sure that each stage will be safe for all those participating and spectating.

Locations

Rally HQ, Media Centre and Service Park will be in the MDS Hotel Concepción, Talcahuano. The Service Park will be located on the same location as 2024 (parking area and surroundings) and it will be the only Service Park used during the rally.

Route

The route consists mostly of twisty gravel stages, challenging both cars and crews. The total distance of the rally is about 1.193,02 km. with sixteen special stages in total. It will cover about 307,48 km, which brings the rally to more than 25,77% special stage coverage.

The rally starts with Shakedown on Thursday morning, meanwhile, the special stages run from Friday morning to Sunday within a 120-kilometre radius around Concepción. The special stage BIOBIO would be welcoming the Wolf Power Stage.

There will be 6 special stages on Friday and Saturday. They will be made up of three unique special stages that will be repeated later on each day. On Sunday the rally will finish with another 4 stages – 2 stages that will be driven twice. The Podium Ceremony will be held at the Stop of the Wolf Power Stage.

1.1. Environmental Policy:

During 2023 Rally Chile BIOBIO achieved three stars -Achievement of Excellence-, the highest level in the FIA's environmental accreditation framework, highlighting areas such as the wildlife protection and commitment to the measurement of carbon footprint, the greenhouse gases neutralization and the environmental impact management of direct rally operations.

This recognition forces us to look after the protection of nature with high standards in innovation of environmental care.

Our competition routes are known for their abundant forests, rivers, wetlands and natural wildlife hotspots, in which Rally Chile BIOBIO has committed to be protagonist in its protection. These guidelines are represented through the environmental policy of the Rally Chile BIOBIO.

Rally Chile BIOBIO's goal is to continue to make the event more sustainable. Each of the internal and external operations seeks to maintain objectives, measurements and records to minimize potential impacts on the environment. This process is in permanent development and has a scope not only in the stages, service park and event activities, but also considers suppliers, society and stakeholders in general.

Specific goals of the organization are:

- Developing a strengthened Sustainability and Environment Protocol that allows recording, measuring and improving potential impacts.
- Constituting a high-level environmental governance within the organization of the event.
- Determination of each stage based on a "multilayer criteria" - Multilayer Assessment of Career Determination (M.A.C.D.) where the initial Stages proposal from the Clerk of The Course is subjected to an exhaustive evaluation for the Conservation of Nature, considering national laws, international agreements such as WETLAND RAMSAR SITES by UNESCO and interested parties (NGO's) among others.
- Register and provide detailed information to aircrafts, of all natural ecosystems identified in the assessment and apply a strict prohibition of their overflight at less than 500 feet of altitude so as not to significantly disturb different competing Ecological Points of Interest (E.P.I.) or areas of High Conservation Value Areas (HCVA) .
- Apply measures to protect and reduce impacts on native vegetation and fauna.
- Educate and communicate as many people as possible both within the organization and externally of our environmental policy, through activities that bring nature closer to the community.
- Comply with environmental laws and regulations of Chile, and other environmental requirements as well as the FIA Institute Environmental Certification Framework.
- Considering environmental work and impact when we choose partners and suppliers, and strive to choose products and services with proven and good environmental performance.
- Seeking to limit our transports' environmental impact as much as possible and minimizing the amount of fuel used by officials working on the event.
- Saving energy and using renewable energy sources where possible, minimizing waste, recycling waste and energy. .
- Reduce the number of printed materials, using only - if it's possible- digital sources or preferring papers from Sustainable Forest Management and Controlled Sources under seals such as PEFC and FSC.
- Complete identification neutralization of Greenhouse Gases through:
 - Measurement of the Carbon Footprint in Scopes 1, 2 and 3 using high performance protocols such as the GHG Protocol of the World Resource Institute - WRI
 - Verification reviewed by an independent third party (Deloitte)

- Neutralization of the entire Carbon Footprint through Certified Emission Reduction (Carbon Credits) registered in the Clean Development Mechanism - CDM of the United Nations Framework on Climate Change and communicating the event's environmental efforts through activities with selected WRC crews in order to promote the competition's high commitment to caring for the environment.

4.2. Entry Procedure

Closing date and time for entries is Tuesday, 12 August at 23.59 CET (17:59 CLT)

Those wishing to take part in Rally Chile BIOBIO 2025 must register and fill in the electronic entry form published at <https://registrations.fia.com/wrcchl> duly completed before the closing date for entries.

Please note that the FIA registration platform requires a user ID and a password to access the entry system. The entry will only be accepted if accompanied by the total amount of the entry fee. To be accepted, competitors must send a proof of payment of the entry fee by e-mail to the secretary of the rally (eberrios@rallychilebiobio.com) by the closing date of entries. Foreign drivers must submit an approval from their ASN.

Referring to Art 6.2.1 and Art 6.3.1 of the 2025 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, the drivers willing to score points in WRC2 or WRC3 Championship must register with the FIA before the closing date of entries of the first rally entered.

4.3 Entry Fees

Manufacturers, other WRC cars and competitors in the Support Championships

Entry fees for Manufacturers, WRC Teams and competitors in all WRC Support Championships (i.e. WRC2, WRC3 as defined in the 2025 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations) are waived from the WRC Rally Chile BIOBÍO 2025.

Entry fees for non-priority competitors are also waived from the WRC Rally Chile BIOBÍO 2025.

For drivers registered in the COPEC RallyMobil Championship the entry fee will be 9 UF + VAT

If a competitor wishes to decline Organiser's optional advertising a charge of €2,000 will apply. This applies also to any competitor entered in class RC1 if not Manufacturer or WRC Team.

Participation in reconnaissance only € 1.500

5. SERVICE PARK

5.1. General Information

5.2. Access to Service Park

Exemptions could be agreed with Service Park Manager.

Please contact the Service Park Manager for direction to your allocated service area.

Access

Only vehicles with Team plates issued by the Organiser are allowed to access the Service Park. The vehicles must be clearly identified by designated car pass affixed on the windscreen. Removal of the sticker is prohibited until the end of the rally.

Closing

All service buildings, tents, cars, trailers etc must be removed from the Service Park area:

- (Manufacturers teams) by Monday, 15 September at 07.00
- Rest of the Service Park (all other teams) by Monday, 15 September at 12.00

5.3. Service Area

- Manufacturers and WRC Teams entered to the FIA WRC will have their designated areas in the Service Park according to the Championship Regulations.

Cost for additional service space in Service Park area is 30 € + VAT 19% /m² = 35.7 €/m².

All additional space requests are subject to availability and organiser agreement. The organiser cannot guarantee any service space exceeding those given above and in the FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Appendix VI.

If a competitor has multiple entries to be located together in Service Park, the application for consecutive Service Areas must reach the Organiser by Thursday, 14 August.

The layout of Service Park displaying service space designated to each competitor will be published in the Competitors section on www.rallychilebiobio.com and on Sportity application.

5.3.1 Traffic Movement

The traffic flow direction shown on the Service Park layout must be always respected by competitors and their service / auxiliary vehicles.

5.3.2 Parking

During the rally, only vehicles with Service and Auxiliary passes will be permitted to access the service park. Auxiliary vehicles may only enter the service park to bring or collect personnel and/ or equipment and only while no competition cars in the service park. Due to the restricted space in the Service Park, Non-priority entries will not be given any auxiliary plates. All trailers and tractor units must be removed to the dedicated truck parking area outside the Service Park.

There will be dedicated car parks for Auxiliary, Media, and Officials.

5.3.3 Power Generators

Generators are permitted in the Service Park however these must be super silent diesel or LPG. Generators must be fenced off to restrict access to competent personnel only.

5.3.4 Restrictions

It is forbidden under any circumstances to drill holes in the surface of the Service Park. Teams and competitors are asked to bring weights for tents and other items that need to be fastened.

5.4. Facilities at Service Park

Following facilities will be provided at various points around the service park as per FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Appendix VI.

- Public toilets
- Waste containers and selective collection
- General lighting
- General security
- Car wash (Located outside the Service Park)

- Additional service space (if available)
- Power supply
- Portable toilets at team service area (Priority competitors as per WRC Regulations)

- Waste removal
- Private water supply if available
- Additional security services
- Forklift and scissors lift rental
- Crowd barriers / fencing

5.5. Environmental Requirements

Washing

A car wash facility will be available near the Service Park. Washing cars inside the Service Park is prohibited at any time. Wheels and other parts may be washed in the designated wash bays set up within the Service Park.

Groundsheet

All competitors must put in place a suitable size plastic groundsheet to cover the whole area where service work is being carried out. This groundsheet must be impervious to all fluids. Cleaning of the groundsheets must be done so that no materials are allowed to encounter the ground surface.

Recycling and Waste

For environmental reasons, all competitors are kindly asked to use the recycling areas arranged at the Service Park for waste. It is forbidden to spill any oil or wastewater on the ground in the Service Park. A special container for hazardous waste will be available in the Service Park.

Before leaving the Service Park after the rally (or possible retirement) each team must report to the Service Park Co-ordinator, who will check that their allocated area has been left in good condition.

5.6. Security

Starting from Sunday 07 September until Monday 15 September, Service Park will be open 24h with overnight security provided by the Organiser from 22.00 until 07.00.

However, the Organisers are not responsible for any losses, thefts, or damages etc – all items are left at their owner's risk.

If you require any additional private security on site, please contact the Service Park Manager.

5.7. Medical Care

A medical unit will be established in the Service Park.

5.8. Recovery of the Retired Cars

In agreement with the team representative all retired cars will be transported by the Organiser from the special stage to the nearest access point. Tow truck must be paid in Chilean pesos by the team representative. The Organiser will then contact the team representative for further agreements.

6. TWO-WAY RADIO COMMUNICATION

6.1. Application Procedure

The Chilean Ministry of Telecommunications controls the use of frequencies in Chile and ensures that enough frequencies are equally available to ensure that all users can operate in a cooperative and legal manner.

13.2 Driving in Chile

Motorway tolls

We have motorway tolls in Chile, they must be paid in **CASH ONLY**, Rally cars included (carry always at least \$20.000 Chilean pesos daily).

If you are driving a rental car, a toll device might be included.

Traffic rules

Drive on the right and overtake on the left-hand side of the road.

The driver and all passengers are required to always use front and rear seat belts.

It is illegal to use a hand-held mobile phone whilst driving.

The blood/alcohol limit in Chile is 0 mg. The police have the power to carry out random alcohol tests on drivers at any time and a blood sample will be taken if a driver refuses a breathalyser test.

It is compulsory to have a fluorescent vest in the car.

It is compulsory to carry 2 red reflective triangle which, in the event of the car stopping, must be placed in a conspicuous position, in order to warn following drivers.

Speed limits

Except where a lower speed limit is indicated, the maximum speed limits in Chile are:

Urban areas: 50 km/h

Dual carriageway with motorway characteristics: 100 / 120 km/h

Motorway: 120 km/h

Exceeding the maximum speed limits may result in addition to a cash sanction the withdrawal of the driving licence.
